- 3-Ring Binders for each core class (Math/Sci/History/ELA)
- Dividers for each binder
- Pencils and erasers - last year students used approximately 50 during the whole year
- Lined paper - last year students needed 1 for each binder
- Index Cards - three packs of 100 for making "flash cards"
- Pocket folders
- Other helpful supplies - pouch, colored pencils, markers, stickies, highlighters, glue sticks, hand-held pencil sharpeners, extra erasers
